What's New



Don Kravcik reported that The Road & Track "New Cars" issue (October, 2000) listed the new features on the 2001 Miata. The new model now comes standard with 155 hp from the 1.8 liter engine. The front and rear ends have been changed slightly, with a different taillight treatment and a larger grill opening, with more angular upper corners. There are also larger openings on each side of the grill for brake ducts or possibly fog lights. The car pictured in the magazine has different wheels and is shown in a new light metallic blue. The article also says that the 6-speed transmission is now standard on the LS model as is the perforated leather. The interior now sports white faced gauges with chrome bezels, new seats and new door panels. Read more about it in the October 2000 The Road & Track issue.

Also, Miata.Net reported that the model will have a new color: Teal. There was a teal "test" color many years ago. They suspect this will be similar. Inside, there will be more comfortable redesigned seats with better bolstering and higher seat backs to comply with European requlations. Also new is the VVT Intake (Variable Valve Timing) which adds about 15 more horses! The 2001 model should be available in the September, 2000 timeframe.
