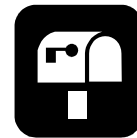
Membership Renewal Time

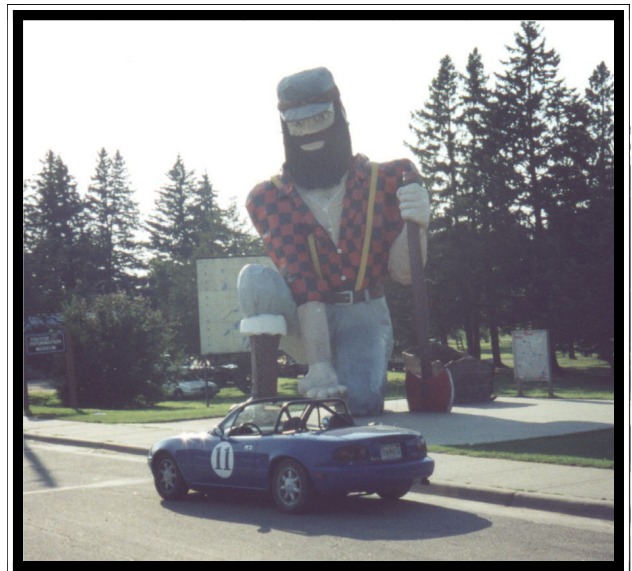

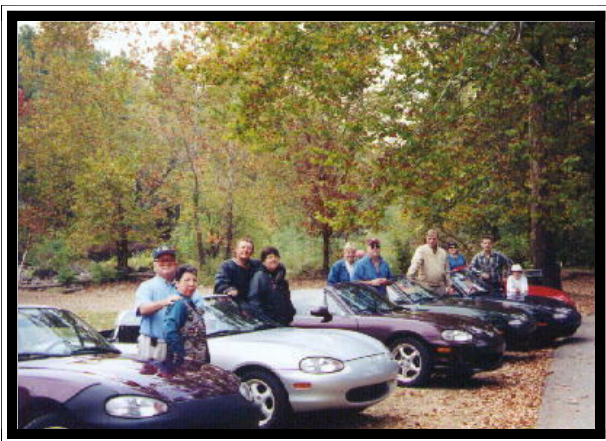

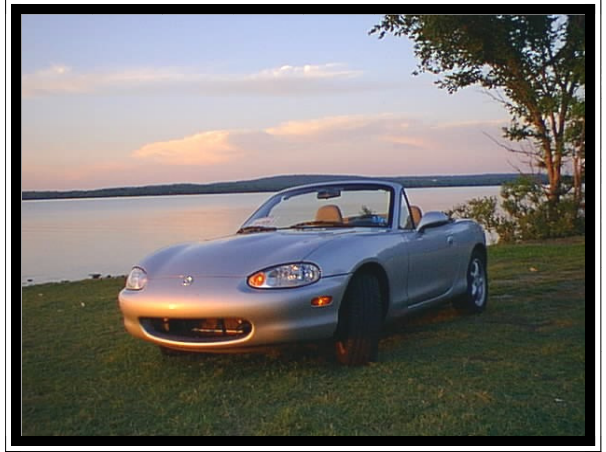

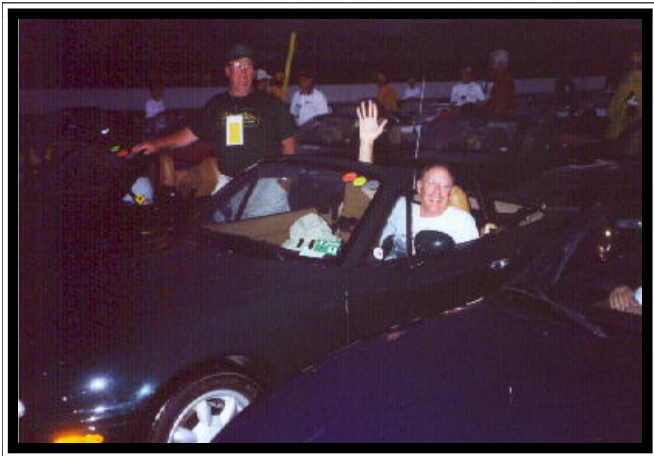

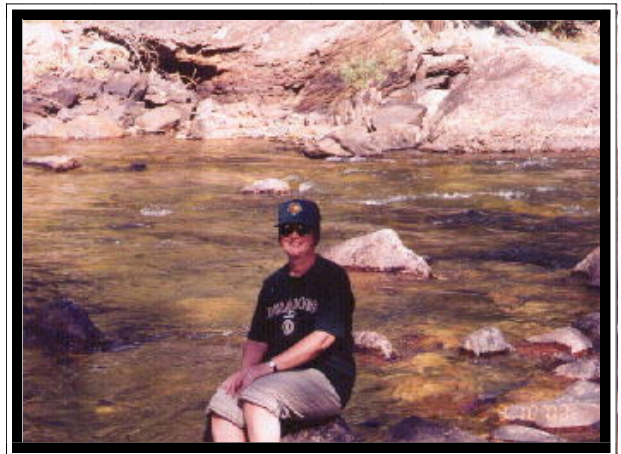
