C. W. Rhodes of the Northwest Arkansas Miata Club has invited our club, the Memphis club, and the Little Rock club to all join together for a large "road run" to Hot Springs. Hopefully we can put together 40 - 50 Miatas for the trip. Forty or fifty Miatas running through towns together make guite a statement about how we feel about our cars and one another. For you older club members who have attended either one or both of the two Arkansas sponsored runs that we have enjoyed these last two Octobers, it will start out very much the same way. We will leave from Broken Arrow and drive straight to Russelville where we join up with the other clubs. There will be a "potty stop" in Sallisaw.

But then, instead of going north on Scenic 7 to Eureka Springs, we will follow Scenic 7 south all the way to Hot Springs. There will be miles and miles of curves, hills, forests, beautiful scenery, and more curves. Some people think the "southern route" is more beautiful and a more challenging drive than is the "northern route." Dorothy and I love it all, from end to end. We hope you will too.

Plot within a plot: Some of our out of state friends love to gamble. That is the reason we have to leave so early. We must meet the other clubs in Russelville by 9:00 AM in order to re-fuel, potty, stretch our legs, and be ready to depart by 9:30 AM sharp. The first race in Hot Springs begins at 1:00 PM and they want to be there for all of the day's races. Upon arrival in Hot Springs they are not even going to check in at the hotel; they are going straight to the track. When the day's races are over they will go straight to our hotel. We plan to

gather for dinner in the hotel about 7:00 PM. After dinner, for those so inclined, we intend to go for drinks and dancing at the historic Arlington Hotel. Party as long as you like; going to bed whenever you like.

Sunday's venue is up to each individual club. Some are going to remain for a second day of gambling. Some are going to have breakfast and then head for home. We shall decide what we are going to do in a discussion amongst those who attend. If you are tired, worn out and just want to go home, I'll bring you back by the fastest and most direct route. But if you still want to "play," I'll bring you back over Taimena Drive. We will eat in Queen Wilhimena Lodge on the top of the mountain, then on to Red Oak and Robbers Cave. We will be back in Tulsa before dark with great stories to tell and incredible pictures to show.

Now about that gambling. I first discussed this at the January club meeting where ten cars said they would be attending the week-end but might not go to the racetrack. Fine. There are no fewer than five lakes around Hot Springs with great Miata roads. Hot Springs offers fabulous shopping. Last but not least, do not forget that Hot Springs was made world famous by its bath houses in which you may get the full treatment sauna, bath, massage. Something to consider. Some of you see no point leaving at 5:00 AM if you do not intend to go to the racetrack. You would prefer to leave at 8:00 or 9:00 AM. We can do that, and if that is what we vote to do, we will do that, But please be aware that if we arrive in Russelville three to four hours late, we will not be driving with the other clubs and instead of seeing 40 - 50 Miatas going by at one time, there will just be 10 - 20; not nearly as impressive.

Where are we going to stay? We will be spending the night at the Hill Wheatley Downtowner Hotel. The cost will be \$58.00 plus tax per room. You must make your own reservation in your own name but tell them you are with the Miata Club and want the special group rate. The individual price is considerably higher, espe-

cially during racing season. The toll free number for group reservations is 1.800.874.7798. That number is a booking agency in Atlanta, Georgia. If you want a view ask for the balcony. The direct number to the hotel is 1.501.624.5521 & the general reservations number is 1.800.251.1962. Warning: Do not wait too long to reserve your room. Only 30 rooms are being held for our clubs. 50 cars would require 50 rooms, see my point/
