GOING TO GO DOWN SOME HILLS THAT IF YOUR BRAKES FAIL, IT IS REALLY GOING TO BE UNPLEASANT. IS YOUR ENGINE FULL OF GOOD CLEAN OIL? HOW IS YOUR TRANSMISSION FLUID? ABOUT THE WEATHER: RAIN OR SHINE, WE GO; YOU CANNOT CANCEL YOUR RESERVATION THAT DAY BECAUSE OF "BAD WEATHER." DRY CREEK LODGE REQUIRES "TWO-WEEKS" WARNING FOR A CANCELLATION. IF IT RAINS WE JUST DRIVE SLOWER AND "SOAK-UP" THE SCENERY.

ABOUT THE ROUTE: SUNDAY'S ROUTE WILL HAVE 331 MILES OF TWO-LANE CURVES WHICH WILL BE FOLLOWED BY 111 MILES OF FOUR-LANE HIGHWAYS FOR A TOTAL DAILY MILEAGE OF 442 MILES. ON SUNDAY WE WILL LEAD THE CLUB OVER SEVEN NEW STRETCHES OF ROAD WE HAVE NEVER TAKEN THE CLUB OVER BEFORE. AND THAT'S A GOOD THING; YOU ARE LEARNING MORE AND MORE NEW PLACES TO GO "PLAY." THE TOTAL MILEAGE FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK-END WILL BE 760 MILES.

THIS WILL BE THE LAST TIME THAT WE CAN COMMUNICATE WITH YOU IN THE NEWS LETTER BEFORE OUR DEPARTURE SO PLEASE READ THIS ISSUE CAREFULLY AND THEN TAKE IT WITH YOU ON THE TRIP. BY NOW YOU SHOULD HAVE A "TWO-WAY" RADIO AND AN OKLAHOMA PIKE PASS. IN ADDITION, YOU SHOULD HAVE AT LEAST \$300.00 "STUFFED" IN YOUR ENVELOPE. WE ARE GOING TO ASSUME YOU HAVE ALL OF THAT AND MOVE ON.

WHETHER YOUR RADIO IS BRAND NEW OR SEVERAL YEARS OLD, BE SURE YOU PUT "BRAND NEW BATTERIES IN IT THE WEEK WE ARE LEAVING. THOSE BATTERIES WILL BE TURNED ON FOR MANY HOURS BOTH DAYS SO THEY NEED TO BE "FRESH AND NEW." RADIO INFORMATION: ALL THESE RADIOS ADVERTISE THAT THEY WILL BROADCAST ONE TO FIVE MILES. BUT THAT DISTANCE IS BASED TOTALLY UPON BEING ON FLAT GROUND WITH NO OBSTRUCTIONS OF ANY KIND IN BETWEEN. WE WILL FREQUENTLY BE IN MOUNTAINS, UP AND DOWN, ROUND AND AROUND. SUCH "GEOGRAPHIC BLOCKS" WILL REDUCE OUR BROADCASTING RANGE TO AS LOW AS 100-300 YARDS AT TIMES.

IT IS CRUCIAL THAT INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE "LEAD CAR" BE "RELAYED" OVER AND AROUND THESE MOUNTAINS. IF WE DON'T "RELAY" TO ONE ANOTHER, FOR ONE ANOTHER, 75% OF OUR DRIVERS WILL NEVER HEAR ANYTHING THAT THE LEAD CAR IS TRYING TO TELL THEM. HOW IS THIS POSSIBLE YOU SAY? ON A FLAT FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY, 35 CARS WILL STRETCH OUT AT LEAST TWO MILES. IN THE MOUNTAINS, IN THE

CURVES, THOSE SAME 35 CARS WILL STRETCH OUT THREE-FOUR MILES. WE MUST RELAY; WE MUST REPEAT MESSAGES. AND MESSAGES ARE NOT JUST FROM FRONT TO BACK. IF THERE IS AN ACCIDENT, A MECHANICAL BREAK-DOWN, SOME ONE GETS LOST, SOMEONE GETS SICK, SOMEONE GETS PULLED OVER BY THE LOCAL CONSTABALE, ALL OF THIS BEHIND THE "LEAD CAR," WE WILL HAVE NO WAY OF KNOWING IT UNLESS ALL OF YOU "RELAY" THE MESSAGE FORWARD UNTIL YOU KNOW THE INFORMATION HAS EACHED THE "LEAD CAR."

A FEW WORDS ABOUT GETTING "LOST." YOU MUST ALWAYS BE AWARE OF WHERE YOU ARE IN THE LINE AND WHO IS BEHIND YOU. IN FACT, YOU ARE ALWAYS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL OF THE CARS THAT ARE FOLLOWING YOUR CAR. IF WE ARE TURNING OFF THE ROAD WE HAVE BEEN DRIVING ON, YOU MUST LOOK IN YOUR REAR VIEW MIRROR AND BE ABSOLUTELY CERTAIN THAT THE CAR IMMEDIATELY BEHIND YOURS SEES YOU MAKE THAT TURN. IF YOU DON'T SEE THAT CAR BEHIND YOU AT ALL, SLOW DOWN, IF NECESSARY, STOP, BECAUSE IF THE CAR FOLLOWING YOU DOESN'T SEE YOU MAKE THAT TURN, HE WILL LEAD ALL THE CARS FOLLOWING HIM THE WRONG WAY; NOT ONE CAR LOST, 20 CARS LOST!!! REMEMBER, AT ALL TIMES YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL THE CARS FOLLOWING YOURS. IF YOU SEE HIS TURN SIGNALS COME ON AND START FLASHING YOU MAY PROCEED AND COMPLETE YOUR TURN.

IN TOWNS WITH TRAFFIC SIGNALS FOLLOW EACH OTHER AS CLOSELY AS IS SAFE; IT DISCOURAGES OTHER DRIVERS FROM "BREAKING INTO" OUR LINE AND GETS MORE OF OUR CARS THROUGH EACH ROTATION OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNALS. BUT IN THE COUNTRY, IN THE CURVES, SPREAD OUT. DO NOT ALLOW ONE CAR HITTING A DEER TO TURN INTO 25 MIATAS SMASHING EACH OTHER TO BITS! DON'T ALLOW YOURSELF TO JUST FOCUS ON THE LICENSE TAG OR TAIL-LIGHTS ON THE CAR IN FRONT OF YOU, DETERMINED TO "STICK TO HIS REAR LIKE GLUE." BIKERS CALL THIS PHENOMENON
