#### "Note from Earl"

When "Pops on 66" first opened it was hailed as Route 66's next icon. But according to Oklahoma Today magazine and the Route 66 Touring Association, it already has become a Route 66 icon. Having been there this summer with Wild Child and talked to the manager, it is

easy to believe.

If you stop there during the summer, no matter what day of the week it is, the odds are at least 50-50 that you will stand in line, outside of the building, while you wait to enter and be seated. People come here by the bus-loads, car clubs and motorcycle clubs come here in huge numbers. WHY? Its just so different!

First, they claim to have over 500 different kinds of soda pop from all over America and 32 foreign countries. If you walk around inside and look at, and try to count, all the different kinds of pop they have there, you start to believe their claims. Wall after wall, shelf after shelf, there is pop everywhere.

What about the food? Their food is very good but it is not cheap; this is not McDonalds. Expect to pay \$7:00-\$8:00 for a sandwich or a burger. They have other selections, other kinds of food, and it will cost more but it will taste very good.

We chose early October to do this drive for two reasons: (1)Hopefully, to see a reduction in the size of the Saturday crowds and (2)For the temperatures to have cooled enough to be comfortable to sit outside. Pops has an outside courtyard that will seat over 40 people easily. If there is a large number of people waiting outside in line when we get there, our willingness as a group to accept the outside seating would send us to the head of the line.

This is a drive for everyone; the pace will be leisurely. There will be no challenging, winding roads and we will obey all speed limits. This drive is strictly about just cruiseing to a really unique place for a good meal with your Miata friends. We will return to Tulsa by a slightly different route and should be back in Tulsa between 2:30-3:00 P.M.

The route that we will take there is 106 miles long. If by the time we get there you think you need more gas for the return trip home, this place also sells gas and their set-up looks like the refueling ports for the Starship Enterprise. Bring your cameras.
