This will be a close-to-home drive over a couple of nearby fun roads ending up in Sapulpa at about 11:00 for lunch at Fat Charlie's Grill; a place of great hamburgers and lot of other wonderful "comfort" food.

After lunch we have a guided tour of a "new" Route 66 attraction, "The Waite Phillips Filling Station Museum". This filling station was built in 1922 by Waite Phillips. The building has been restored by the Sapulpa Historical Society and is currently used as a museum. The museum houses automobiles from the 1920s and is located one block off historic Route 66.

# MIATAS AT TULSA RACEWAY PARK, FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2011: JOE BOHANNON

When: Friday, Oct 7, 2011, 6:00 - 11:00 PM Where: Tulsa Raceway Park, 3101 N. Garnett, Tulsa, Ok

Once again the big race is set in early October. It was rained out last year and is now set. The details are as follows:

The drag races are held in what is called "bracket racing" format. This system equalizes all cars to a common base, i.e. your ability to estimate the time of your car for 1/4 of a mile. This is known as the "dial in time". You will get two trial runs to get your time down for the actual race. all starts are from a light tree and if you jump the green light you loose unless both do, then the times will determine the winner. The goal is to equal your time estimate or just go over. if you are Under your estimate, this means you ran faster and loose assuming the other car goes over. The one closest to the dial in time without going under is the winner for each race.

The cost is \$20.00 for drivers who want to race, and \$10.00 admission for others. You need to have a helmet available and will run with the top up. There is a technical inspection of each car prior to racing. You need to wear long pants and a top with either short or long sleeves if you plan to race. You can bring your own numbers for the car or they will assign you one and put it on the window. Windows must be up when racing. Depending on the number of cars that show up, we will set up brackets to have a winner and looser and the winners will race winners until we have an overall winner. Both people in a car can drive, and the cost would then be \$40.00 total. Food and drinks are available and you cannot bring your own. If there is enough interest, we can have an outright challenge race bracket for

the fastest Miata for the 1/4 mile, i.e. fastest car wins.

The address is 3101 N. Garnett, Tulsa. exit 169 at Pine going north, go east to Garnett (1/2 mile) and go north on Garnett to the main entrance on your right. If not racing, park outside the pit area entry gate, otherwise pay as you enter with your car through the gate with the guard house to the pit area. The races should be over around 11 pm. If rainy, call me first to confirm the race is on.

Earl commented that riding withGeorge and watching the many coordinated movements of George's hands and feet "would put Fred Astaire to shame".

For those who might be interested there is a half price coupon for lst timers racing at Hallett in November. George said that the Arkansas Miata club has been sponsoring Miatas at Hallett every year and next year will be their last doing so.
