July 21, Saturday, "Spiro Mounds" History & Bar-B-Que Drive: Drivers meeting at 8:15am at the Quick Trip, 81st & Hwy 51, east side of Broken Arrow (line up on South side of QT). Depart at 8:30. Fuel filled, Oil checked, Tire air pressure checked, Radio with fresh batteries, Pike Pass Not needed, Restaurant will take paper or plastic. You will need \$4.00 for adults or \$3.00 for senior admission to the Spiro site.

We'll visit the Spiro,Oklahoma's only prehistoric Native American archaeological site about 10:30. The 150-acre site encompasses 12 southern mounds, which contain evidence of an Indian culture that occupied the site from 850 A.D. to 1450 A.D. One of the most important American Indian sites in the nation, the Spiro Mounds are world renowned because of the incredible amount of art and artifacts dug from the Craig Mound, the site's only burial mound. We will spend about 1 ½ hours here touring and visiting the site. There is a museum with artifacts and walking trails to view the mounds and house. We will lunch just down the road at the Wild Horse Mountain Bar-B-Que, 918-775-9960. Home around 3:30 to a local Braum's for an evening treat.

This drive will have 125 miles of cruising roads to the site and challenging turns and hills on our return flight with frequent "pit stops" both ways.
