January 28th, Monday evening Moonrise Drive. We will meet at the Braums at Hwy 51 and 81st Street (8136 E Hwy 51, Broken Arrow) at 7:00 P.M. Drivers meeting convenes at 7:15. We'll assemble in the parking lot for queue up at 7:22 and roll out at 7:29. This will be a relatively short, relaxed drive. The drive will require your full attention to the road and all cars around you 100% of the time and will require you to be a good follower. April 20-21, Saturday & Sunday, "Spring Fling" Drive: This will be a 2 day drive spending Saturday night, April 20 at the Super 8 motel in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Make your reservations before April 1, at 1-501-525-7449 or Paul at 1-501-542-0219 (his cell). Our club rate is \$65.94 which includes tax and free hot breakfast.

In order to make the scenic drive of 260 miles with "potty breaks" to Hot Springs, AR for lunch, we will need to depart from Quick Trip located at 8101 E. Highway 51 in Broken Arrow at **7 a.m.** sharp Saturday, April 20. Driver's meeting at **6:45 a.m**. We should arrive about noon on Saturday and go to lunch on Lake Hamilton at Fisherman's Wharf – they offer all kinds of sea food, steaks, chicken, sandwiches and salads. After lunch we will check in to our hotel, take a driving tour of the Hot Springs Mountain National Park area, and then break into small groups for a walking tour of "Old Town" where we will check out the shops and old bath houses. If it has been a while, you may want to take a hot bath and knock off a few years (of dirt). You will want to have dinner in "Old Town" at one of the many restaurants before returning to the hotel for an evening of rest.

Sunday, April 21, we will have a hot breakfast at the hotel and check out before 9 a.m. We will have a driver's meeting at 9 a.m. with our departure at 9:15 a.m. We will head out Hwy 7 for a scenic drive through Hot Springs Village, the Blue Quachita Mountain range and on to Russellville where we will take Hwy 40 to our lunch stop about noon. After a neat lunch we will head home via highways arriving back about 3:30 p.m.

You should start this drive with a full tank of fuel, tires, radio with fresh batteries, and engine checked for belts, hoses and fluids with your Pike Pass and NEO Miata Logo on the sides.
