Our regularly scheduled meeting for February 20 was postponed to February 27 due to inclement weather.

First Meeting to Attend

Although not new members, Ann & John Hill, Joyce & Jim Weaver and George Kiefer all attended their first NEO Miata Club meeting on February 27.

Bill Curts called the meeting to order at 7 PM. Member introductions were made.

Bill Curts led a discussion to add an Associate Member classification to the Club Guidelines. This discussion had been done in previous meetings but no vote had ever been taken of the Club Members. Bill proposed adding an Associate Member which was described as "one who has been an active regular member for three years or more and for some reason does not own or drive a Mazda Miata. An Associate Member will pay dues, may participate in all activities, but is limited in that he/she may go on drives but will have to travel behind the "Sweep" and have the club logo displayed on his/her car or ride with someone else in a Miata." A Motion was made by David Laughery and seconded by Pierre Smith to accept adding the Associate Member classification to the Club Guidelines.

Discussion of the Motion followed. An Amendment to the Motion was made to drop the three year requirement and allow a Regular Member to become an Associate Member regardless of how long they had belonged to the Club. A Motion was made by Joe Bohannon and seconded by Pierre Smith to accept the Amendment to the Motion. A vote was taken of the Members attending the meeting and the Motion to add an Associate Member classification passed.

Jeff Lewis of Nelson Mazda was the Guest Speaker. He presented the Club with a \$500 check from Nelson Mazda as appreciation for the Club. Jeff discussed the changes being made in the Mazda models by going to their Sky Activ development. He also discussed the rumors that the Miata was going to be discontinued. This rumor appears to be false. Mazda and Alfa Romeo are developing a partnership that will combine the development teams of both companies to re-design a car that will be for both companies and sold by each company. No timeframe for the re-deign has been officially announced.

Officer Reports:

Vice President: Ric Fornell made a presentation, including slides, from his recent trip to the Daytona Racetrack Secretary: Andy Anderson reported that 64 Members had paid 2013 dues. There are currently 112 Members on the Roster. Webmaster: Nothing to report. Treasurer: No report. Events: Bob passed around a paper asking Members to list their favorite place to eat so that we could have some "destination" drives.
