22 - Meet & Eat / Go find It: Rick Fornell

This will be a new twist on our traditional "Meet & Eat" club outing. I'm going to call this a "Go-Find-It contest. Much like a scavenger hunt but you won't need to get out of your car to participate. **On Sunday**, yes it's on a Sunday, we will meet at Charlie Mitchell's, 4848 South Yale at 3:00 p.m. I will give each car a Go-Find-It score sheet. Each score sheet will be divided into three sections.

<u>Section #1</u> has a listing of letters from A to Z. Each letter represents a street name that you must drive on for a minimum of three blocks (100 yards) before you can claim it on your score pad and is worth **two points**. Example: D_______, this could be Denver, Detroit, or Delaware etc. When you have driven your three block minimum you simply fill the street name in the blank and proceed to the next letter.

<u>Section #2</u> has a listing of places or things you must find, and each is worth **three points**. Example: Bowling Alley______, Dead End Street______ etc. When you find these items or places simply make an X in the blank and proceed to the next item.

<u>Section #3</u> is a bonus section of places and is worth **five points** each. Just make an "X" in the blank when you find each item.

We will meet again at Charlie Mitchells at 5:00 where we will have diner. This will give you exactly two hours to complete your score card. At diner we will tally the score cards and select a winner. You must keep in mind that this is just for FUN and you are on the <u>"HONOR SYSTEM"</u>. Please call me or e-mail me so I can give Charlie Mitchell's a head count for diner.
