**11 - Road Rally:** We will meet at 9:00am at the HIRE CALL parking lot, which is located on RIVERSIDE just south of the 71st and RIVERSIDE intersection. There will be an Entrants Meeting at 9:20am to go over the instructions. We will go over the instructions to make sure the entrants understand them. We don't want folks out wandering around totally lost. The first car will leave shortly after the meeting. This should be no later than 10:00am.

You should bring the following to the event:

- 1. A watch that you can read the hour, minute and second.
- 2. A clipboard to hold the instructions.
- 3. A few pencils to check off the instructions with.

There are those of you that may wish to eat or fuel near the start. There are several choices as you head west on 71st, approaching from Lewis. On your right are Braum's, Taco Bell and Wendy's. There is a QT for fuel on your right. On your left are McDonald's, Subway and Burger King. There is also a Starbuck's on your left next to the Subway.

The route is all paved and is less than 100 miles in length. The route is mostly in Tulsa County, but we do visit Creek and Osage Counties. Remember that this route was devised for a winter run, so the route stays close to Tulsa and mostly runs on city streets, county roads and a few residential areas. I stated at the May Miata Meeting that you would see residences that were worth hundreds of thousands of dollars and those that were worth literally hundreds of dollars. You will be on divided highways and roads slightly wider than your car. You will cross multi-lane wide bridges over the Arkansas and one-lane wide "plank" bridges. There will be a "half-way" rest break in the Sand Springs area. We will finish near a place to eat in the Jenks area.

There will be a \$5.00 entry fee per car. The entry fee will be used to cover the cost of printing and awards. George and I discussed the awards and came to the conclusion that the awards should be something that all the entrants can use. We agreed on gas cards. Three cards will be given to Miata entrants. One card will be given to the first half winner and one card to the second half winner. One card will be given to the overall winner.

This rally will also be open to other entrants, however, Miata entrants will be competing against only other Miata entrants and only Miata entrants are guaranteed the three gas cards.
