Tom Mattox called the July meeting to order at Uncle Bucks, inside of the Bass Pro Shop in Broken Arrow, at seven pm. He asked if there were any new members there and Vicki Schaff stood up, she owns a white 2006 Miata. The members introduced themselves and told about their cars.

- Ric Fornell, Vice President, spoke about a drive he is planning, to the Canebrake, near Wagoner OK.
- Ron Coates, Secretary, reported that we have 77 paid members.
- Andy Anderson, Treasurer, reported the club has a balance of \$2334.82.
- Alan Doughty, Club Webmaster, had nothing new to report.
- Bob Schwarz reported on the road rally that the club had on July 11th. It turned out to be a fun event.

Under "new business", President, Tom Mattox asked for volunteers to join a panel to help with social functions. If you are willing to lend a hand, please email Tom at President@neomiata.com.

Earl Larkin rose to say a FEW words at the meeting. He warned the members that he was going to hold a drive for those who like to drive the Miata in the way the Miata is designed to be driven....the car is MADE for curves. In August, the drive will have over six hundred curves!

Former club president, Bill Curts, gave us answers to maintenance questions for our MX-5's. He explained things like First Generation cars were built from 1989 to 1998. Second Generation cars went from 1999 to 2005. And in those first two generations, the timing belt needed to be changed every 90,000 miles. But when the Third Generation cars came out, they had a metal belt, that does not need changed. Generation "C" or Third Generation came out in 2006 through 2015. Bill explained a lot about how much cars have changed in our lifetimes. No longer a high beam switch on the floor, no longer do cars have fender skirts, suicide knob on the steering wheel nor curb finders. Bill brought a variety of chemicals and waxes to show. He explained why he liked the brands he prefers..such as Meguires auto products and Turtle brand tire shine. Installing a louder horn, and a third brake light flasher are a couple things that many Miata owners like to install. He also explained how to wire your car so that the fog lights will stay on with your high beams. He recommended members go to Miata.net for more tips on how to maintain their cars.

Ric Fornell explained some of the "rules of the road".....like full tank of gas, and empty bladder. Bring a radio tuned to channel 5. and do not lose track of the car following you, if you make a turn, be sure the car behind hou can SEE you made the turn. You can find more of these rules at the neomiata.com website. Superwrench is a company that knows Miatas, and Ric recommends them highly.

- 1. One room with two Queen-Sized beds or one King-Sized bed: \$ 95.43. This price includes all taxes.
- 2. One room with one King-Sized bed and a Jacuzzi: \$ 125.00 plus all taxes.
- 3. One room with one King-Sized bed, a Jacuzzi, and a fireplace: \$ 145.00 plus all taxes.
