John Ream started the member introductions with a report that he replaced his timing belt and did some other work on his 2001 car. The microphone was passed around so people could brag on their particular Miatas. It seems that Papa Joe Bohannan and Duane Will have the more unusual shades of red that Mazda puts on Miatas!

Bob Schwarz had a few things to tell the club. For instance, the "NA" through "ND" designations for the different Miata generations came from the Vehicle Identification Numbers.....While sometimes we refer to the second generation of Miata's as NB, (cars produced from 1999 to 2005) we often have no idea where this designation came from. If you look at the fourth and fifth characters of your VIN, you will see that they are either ND, NC, NB or NA. Bob also has a complaint about the thin oil that Mazda recommends for newer Miatas. SAE 0W-20. He thinks the oil is too thin, and leads to a metal-to-metal start up.

Under "Old Business", President Mattox reported on the leisurely drive and weekend spent on the Spring Fling drive to the diamond mine in Arkansas. Everyone agreed that we had a pleasant time visiting at the motel in the evenings and at the various meals.
