<u>Meet & Eat April 6, 3 p.m.</u>, Saturday, at the new *Metro Diner, 6620 S. Memorial,* sponsored by Dugger Duncan. Do you remember the old one? I am looking forward to this.

Spring Fling April 12, 13 and 14 Petit Jean State Park Arkansas: Spring is right around the corner and our Spring Fling is coming up fast. April 12, 13 and 14 (Friday night, Saturday night and Sunday morning departure by 11 a.m.) to Petit Jean State Park, south of Russellville AR. Unique geology, legends, nature, interesting ROADS, beautiful flora, pines, quiet.

We will meet at QuikTrip, Hwy 51 and 81st St (across from Blue Bell ice cream plant) at 08:00. Our first pit stop will be Webbers Falls (1 hour). Next pit stop Ozark Travel Center (Exit 35 I-40). Lunch at Stoby's Restaurant, Russellville. Then 40 minutes to Petit Jean State Park for check-in. More details will follow.

Here is the reservation information for the Spring Fling at Petit Jean State Park. State parks give a senior discount for campsites only. Book two nights, April 12, 13. Cabins are \$90/night and include mini-fridges, microwave and wood burning fireplaces but no kitchen. Lodge room \$80/night Departure for return to Tulsa is April 14, Sunday morning. We get the Legacy meeting room free if we have 25 meals each night.

Cabins with kitchens are big and roomy and are \$195 to \$200 per night and can sleep about 6. This is one such large cabin we stayed at.

Reservation cut-off date is March 12. There are 10 cabins and 10 Lodge rooms set aside. If we fill these 20 accommodations there may be some available after that but with diminishing likelihood. If you need to cancel, you must do so by at least 48 hours prior to arrival. Ask about dog friendly rooms/cabins. Rates are single/double occupancy plus applicable state and local taxes. \$12 charge for additional person age 13 years and older. Call 501-727-5431. Give the clerk the event ID# 55580226, Clerk will take your contact information and payment information. Ask about bed type.
