MAY EVENTS

Saturday, May 16th: The Dam drive and lunch. We will meet between 11:00 and 11:15 a.m. in the big parking lot, caddy cornered, southeast of the **QT at 193rd E Ave. and Admiral, in Catoosa, OK.** That is on the south side of I-44 near the big Hard Rock Casino. There is a big, new restaurant called 'Flying Burger and Seafood'. It is mostly black and white and you cannot miss it. Go to the parking lot just to the east side of that restaurant. Drivers meeting at 11:15. We will depart at 11:30 a.m. for Locust Grove. Bob & Linda will lead. Alternatively, you can just meet us at the Country Cottage parking lot at noon.

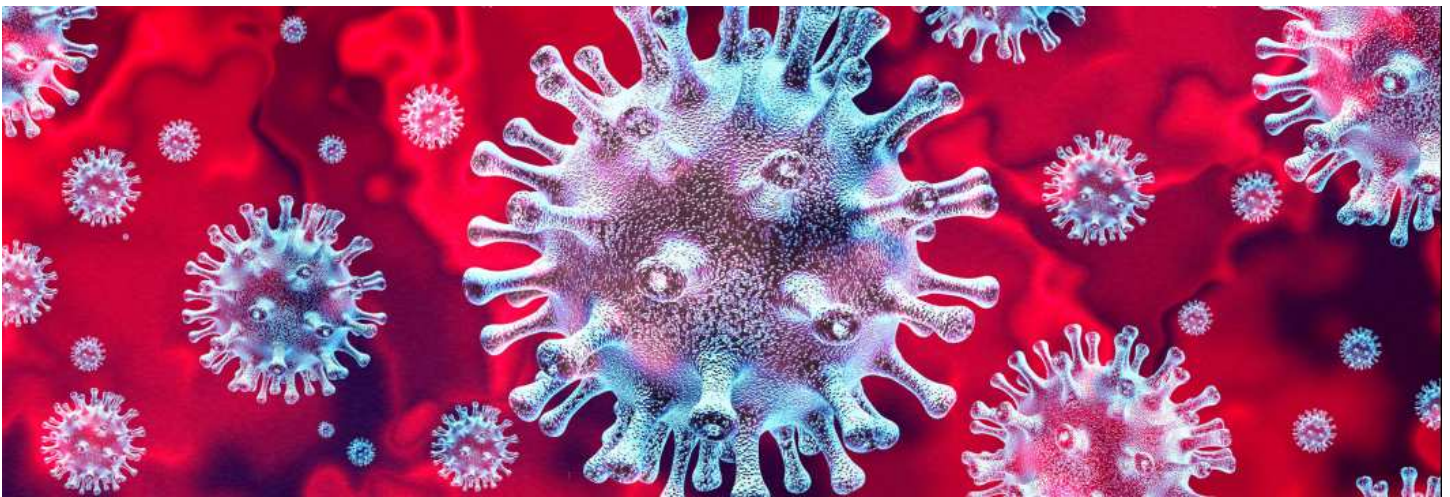
The Tim & Linda Bodine drive this Saturday depends on the weather so check your email on Friday. I know you are hoping the weather cooperates and we get a chance to go.
