Tom also told us about two service plans available on a monthly cost basis. A premium plan for \$34.95/mo. which includes 3 oil changes a year, free battery replacement, and 50% off on tires. They also offer a regular plan for \$19.95/mo. which includes 3 oil changes a year and free battery replacement. I could be off a few pennies on the price and there may be more stuff offered in the plans, so be sure and talk to the service representative at Nelson Mazda for the full details.
